The story behind the musical "Come From Away" Where were you on the day that JFK was assassinated? What were you doing when man landed on the moon? How did you feel when you heard that Princess Dianna had died? The chances are that if I asked you, "How did 9/11 impact you?" I would get the strongest response...

Elias Kanaris was one of 198 passengers on flight UA929, flying between London Heathrow and Chicago O'Hare on that fateful day. His was one of 38 planes that descended into Gander airport on September 11th, 2001.

Now the subject of the musical, "Come From Home", this narrative of resilience is shared by Elias 20 years on.

As a result of 9/11, life seemed to shut down overnight. The airline industry was decimated, and nobody thought it could recover. Yet, despite outward appearances, business returned to normal.
